CHAPTER ONE

GOD'S CHOSEN METHOD — PREACHING!

God has His methods for accomplishing His will and purposes. These methods are the ones that He has chosen and ordained, and can be discovered in The Bible. Although we may be tempted to seek out our own ways and methods of advancement, a discovery of His methods will surely put us on the road toward much greater productivity and spiritual satisfaction. One of His chosen methods is *PREACHING*.

For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God...

*For since, in the wisdom of God, the world through wisdom did not know God, **it pleased God through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who believe...***

*For you see your calling, brethren, that not many wise according to the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called. But **God has chosen** the*

*foolish things of the world to put to shame the wise, and **God has chosen** the weak things of the world to put to shame the things which are mighty; and the base things of the world and the things which are despised **God has chosen**, and the things which are not, to bring to nothing the things that are.*

1 Corinthians 1:18,21,26-28

It's always good to be reminded that it "*pleases God to save those who believe.*" He is always pleased to provide us with salvation, healing, deliverance, protection, and provision. In fact, The Bible reveals that God is not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.¹ He desires for all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.² He is a saving, healing, delivering God! And this is Who He is for all who call upon Him!

And *HOW* does He go about saving, healing, and delivering people? *Through the foolishness of the message preached!* He does it through preaching!

In our high-tech, sophisticated, and often self-sufficient culture, this may seem rudimentary and even "foolish," but nonetheless, this is what God has chosen. ***Preaching is His chosen method.*** You will notice how strongly this theme is emphasized in these verses — "*God has chosen...God has chosen...God has chosen.*"

Is there another way? No. Is there a better way? No. This is God's way!

Since the world in all its fancy wisdom never had a clue when it came to knowing God, God in his wisdom took delight in using what the world considered dumb – preaching, of all things! – to bring those who trust him into the way of salvation.

1 Corinthians 1:21 (MSG)

This verse says that God in His wisdom *took delight in using* preaching, of all things! So what does He use? What is His method? Preaching! This may seem dumb, simple, or like a big waste of time to those who don't understand, but nonetheless, this is still the way God has set things up.

God could have ordained and chosen any method to bring salvation and deliverance into our lives, but as it turns out, ***He chose preaching***. And once He ordains a method, that's His method! You can't change it, but if you are wise, you can learn how to cooperate with it.



CHAPTER TWO

HOW GOD WORKS WITH HUMANITY

One of the things that will help us greatly is to gain an understanding of ***how God works with humanity on the earth***. Once we understand how God works with humanity, it will become clear why preaching is so important.

Some people have the idea that the Lord just does whatever He wants, whenever He wants, with whomever He wants. But did you know that kind of thinking is unscriptural? Some people have the idea that because God is God and because He's sovereign and all-powerful, that He just randomly moves as He chooses.

It's true that God is sovereign! But it's also true, that in His sovereignty, He has bound Himself to His Word.

- o He has exalted His Word above His Name.¹
- o It's impossible for Him to lie.²
- o He will not break His covenant, nor alter the word that has gone out of His lips!³

So we can be sure of this: ***If God says it, then that's the way it is.*** He always moves in our lives within the framework of what He has said. We can always count on that!

Here's a powerful statement that I would like you to stop and consider:

God works with mankind on the basis of what man believes, according to what God has said.

Let's take a moment and break this down. How does God work with mankind? He works with mankind ***on the basis of what man believes.*** In other words, God *CAN* do anything, but His power will be limited or released in our lives on the basis of what we believe.

IF YOU CAN BELIEVE

We find great hope and comfort through commonly quoted verses such as, "*With God, nothing will be impossible.*"⁴ That's good news for sure! Is there something in your life that looks impossible to solve or change? Thank God — with God, nothing will be impossible!

Genesis 18:14 says, "*Is anything too hard for the Lord?*"

What's the obvious answer to that question? No! Nothing is too hard for Him!

Jeremiah 32:27 says, *“Behold, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh. Is there anything too hard for Me?”*

It is clear from these verses, and many of us already have an understanding that ***nothing is impossible or too hard for the Lord***. There's absolutely nothing that God cannot do! There are no impossibilities with Him! He's the God who makes a way where there is no way! He is the God who opens and no man can shut!

But did you know that these verses, as true and reliable as they may be, are incomplete without Mark 9:23?

Jesus said to him, “If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes.”

Mark 9:23

In this account, a father is seeking deliverance for his son who is suffering from seizures as a result of an evil spirit. This man says to Jesus, *“If you can do anything, have compassion on us and help us.”* In response, Jesus ***DID NOT SAY***, *“Don't worry, I am God in the flesh and I can do anything!”* No, He didn't say that.

But what did He say? He said, *“If you can believe...”* For the man who believes, all things are possible!

With this understanding, we realize that the question is not only *what God can do*. Perhaps the more relevant question to ask is ***what can we believe?*** Because, if you can believe, all things are possible to those who believe!

So, although God could do whatever He wants, whenever He wants, with whomever He wants, ***HE DOES NOT!*** And the reason He does not is simply because He didn't set things up to work that way. God works with mankind on the basis of what man believes, *according to what He has said*.

In other words, God will do for you whatever you believe Him to do, provided that what you believe is in agreement with what He has already revealed through His Word.

ACCORDING TO HIS WORD

If it's not revealed through His Word, then we don't have any business trying to believe that God will do it. Trying to do so is *presumption* and not real faith. And in such cases, what we are attempting to believe IS impossible, because we have strayed outside the boundary of the revelation of God's written Word.

In John 15:7, Jesus says, *"If you abide in Me and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you."*

Here Jesus is saying, “*You can ask whatever you want! Whatever you want, it will be done for you!*” But what’s the qualifier here? We must abide in Him with His words abiding in us! So, it’s not enough just to believe and ask for something. What we believe and ask must be according to what God has said.⁵

Do you see it now? God works with humanity on the basis of what man believes, *according to what God has said*. Or we could say it this way:

God works with man on the earth according to that portion of God’s Word that he believes.

That’s a powerful truth!

BECAUSE OF THEIR UNBELIEF

Here’s another powerful statement that will bring even greater clarity to our understanding:

God can do anything, but He is limited by the faith of man. Man’s faith is the limiting factor!

We wouldn’t want to make such strong statements without a scriptural backing. So, let’s take a look at some verses:

Then He went out from there and came to His own country, and His disciples followed Him. And when the Sabbath had come, He began to teach in the synagogue.

And many hearing Him were astonished, saying, “Where did this Man get these things? And what wisdom is this which is given to Him, that such mighty works are performed by His hands! Is this not the carpenter, the Son of Mary, and brother of James, Joses, Judas, and Simon? And are not His sisters here with us?” So they were offended at Him.

*But Jesus said to them, “A prophet is not without honor except in his own country, among his own relatives, and in his own house.” **Now He could do no mighty work there**, except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them. And **He marveled because of their unbelief...***

Mark 6:1-6

Here we read the account of Jesus in His own hometown. When the people heard His Words, they were astounded as they compared the words of power and authority they were hearing with their own personal knowledge and perception of “the carpenter” who stood before them. The Bible says, *“They were offended at Him.”*

And what was the result? “*Now He could do no mighty work there... and He marveled because of their unbelief.*”

This doesn't say that *He WOULD NOT* do any mighty work there. It's not as if Jesus was personally offended and upset, such that He decided to shut down His ministry or hold back His healing power. No, it does not say that! It says He *COULD NOT* do any mighty work there.

Even if Jesus wanted to demonstrate the power of God, He was not able to do so. It may sound strange to hear that Jesus was *unable* to do something, but that is what “could not” really means.

Clearly these people had shut down God's miraculous power operating through Jesus. And what was it that shut down God's power? ***It was their unbelief.*** Can God's will and power be limited? Clearly it was in this case!

We read accounts where Jesus went into other cities and villages and *healed all* who were sick of various diseases and torments.⁶ What was the difference between those other cities and what Jesus experienced among the people in Nazareth? The difference was *faith!*

The same thing is true in life today. God moves where He finds faith! Although He would like to move everywhere, He is limited to where He finds faith.

What was Jesus' response to the unbelief that He encountered? *He went about the villages in a circuit, teaching.* Teaching and preaching is a Bible-cure for unbelief!

If we will be honest, we all have areas of unbelief, where our faith is weak or needs to be strengthened. In some cases, we may have strong faith in one area but not in another. There is no need to be upset, worried, or to feel condemned! Instead just say, *"Lord, please send me a preacher to help strengthen my faith in this particular area!"*

CAN GOD BE LIMITED?

*How often they provoked Him in the wilderness, and grieved Him in the desert! Yes, again and again they tempted God, **and limited the Holy One of Israel.***

Psalm 78:40,41

When the Lord brought the children of Israel out of Egyptian bondage on their way into "the promised land," an entire generation got stuck and ended up dying in the wilderness because of their unbelief.⁷

These verses reveal even more explicitly that these people *LIMITED GOD*. That almost sounds outrageous! Is it possible to limit a limitless God? Evidently so!

And the same exact thing happens in our own lives when we have unbelief.

What did these people say? What words were coming out of their mouths?

If you will stop for a moment and listen to people long enough (including yourself), you will eventually discover what they really believe.

What you believe is not just what you utter when you are saying prayers or when you are in church. What you really believe is what comes out of your mouth in abundance, in everyday life, when the pressure is on! These are ultimately the words that end up ruling and governing our lives.

What did the Israelites say? They said, *“Can God prepare a table in the wilderness? Can He provide meat for His people?”*⁸ Do you hear this language? This doesn’t sound like the language of faith. It sounds like the language of doubt and unbelief. And this is exactly the kind of heart attitude that limited what God was able to do in their lives. The Bible says, *“they limited the Holy One of Israel.”*

God wanted to do so much more for them! He wanted to bring them into the rightful inheritance that He had

promised! He wanted to bring them into all that He had planned and prepared for them! But as much as He wanted it, HE COULD NOT.

What was it that held the Israelites back? What was it that kept God back? It was their unbelief and lack of faith.

Let's be reminded of this: **God can do anything, but He is limited by the faith of man. Man's faith is the limiting factor.**

FAITH IS REQUIRED

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.

But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord.

James 1:5-7

The Bible teaches us that if we lack wisdom, we can ask of God and He will give to all liberally and without finding fault. But we are instructed as to the manner in which we must ask — *“But let him ask in faith with no doubting.”*

What's the problem with doubting? The same passage says, "*He who doubts is like a wave of the sea, driven and tossed by the wind. For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord.*" We do not receive when we doubt.

So, whether we are asking for wisdom, or whatever the case may be, if there is doubt and unbelief, we will not receive. These are not my words or my opinion. These are God's words!

But without faith, it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Hebrews 11:6

With all this in mind, we gain a much better understanding of why faith pleases God. Why is it *impossible* to please God without faith? It is because "faith" is the very thing that allows God to get involved in human affairs! And that's the very thing He is so eager to do!

God is Love,⁹ and Love is pleased when He can meet the needs of humanity. He is always willing and ready to get involved whenever and wherever He is called upon! Is there anything that would please a loving God more than being able to come to the

full aid and rescue of one of His beloved children? I don't think so. But all of this takes place *by faith*, when we believe what God has spoken.

And here's some good news before we go any further: ***If you are a born-again child of God, you are a believer!*** You are not a doubter!

It's part of your new nature in Christ to believe.¹⁰ In fact, you have been built to believe! But believing doesn't happen accidentally and it does not happen mysteriously — ***faith and believing is a result of preaching!***

What you have read here so far may seem challenging. It may even make you feel slightly angry. For some, it may seem narrow, hard, demanding, unreasonable, or even legalistic — that God would *REQUIRE* faith from us. But we must always remember this:

〔 **For anything that the Lord requires *FROM US*,
He has also made provision *FOR US*.
This is part of His grace in our lives.** 〕

God has provided a solution — He has provided a means — He has provided a surefire and proven way for us to be able to operate in faith and to receive easily from Him. What has God provided for us? He has provided preaching!



CHAPTER THREE

PREACHING BRINGS FAITH

So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Romans 10:17

Stop for a moment and consider this powerful statement:

Faith is the currency of the kingdom of God.

As we have already seen, if you want to operate in the kingdom of God and receive from God, faith is required. Anyone who has traveled internationally knows that if you want to operate within the country you are visiting, you cannot do so for long apart from obtaining that nation's particular currency.

If you are in the United States, you need *US Dollars*. If you are in the Philippines, you better have some *Philippine Pesos*. If your travels bring you to South Korea, you are going to need some *South Korean Won*. If you plan to stay long in Japan, before long you are going to be looking for some *Japanese Yen*.

You might try to pull out your dollars or pesos to transact in Saudi Arabia, but it won't take long before you discover that the merchants there are looking for *Saudi Riyal*. Each of these nations has its own currency. Without these currencies, you can't do business and make transactions.

The same is true of the spiritual nation of the kingdom of God. We have not received a religion. We have received a kingdom!¹ Through our new birth in Christ, we are now a part of God's *holy nation*.² It is from the kingdom of God that we have received our eternal heavenly citizenship.³

The kingdom of God also has its own currency — faith! So, if you want to “transact” in the kingdom, do business in the kingdom, or if you want to have God involved in your affairs, you've got to have heaven's currency.

SINCERELY WRONG

Although we may be sincere and well-meaning, we often try to transact and do business in the kingdom of God by many other means of our own making — through tears, through begging, through fasting, or even through long prayers. But no matter how sincere our efforts, without faith, none of these things are productive. Without faith, *it's impossible* to please God!

Just because we cry to God doesn't mean that any kingdom transaction has been made. Just because we beg God for something doesn't mean that any transaction has been made.

As honest and sincere as I may be with pockets full of US Dollars, and even as hard as I may try, I simply won't be able to transact and do business in most other nations unless I get my hands on some of those currencies. It's possible for any of us to be sincere and yet be sincerely wrong or misdirected.

And here's the good news, friend, and this is why I have written this book:

**Through preaching, you can get your spiritual
hands on the currency of God's kingdom —
faith!**

Romans 10:17 says, "*So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.*" Did you see that? Faith comes! Faith comes! Faith comes! And how does faith come? Faith comes BY HEARING God's Word.



CHAPTER FOUR

THE PROCESS OF RECEIVING FROM THE LORD

For “whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.” How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written:

“How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, who bring glad tidings of good things!”

...So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Romans 10:13-15,17

These verses reveal to us **the process of receiving from the Lord.**

This is the Lord’s process, and it will work for anyone! Once you understand this process, you can begin to more readily cooperate with it — on purpose! Here’s the simple process revealed through these verses:

Preaching brings hearing.

Hearing brings believing.

Believing brings speaking and doing.

Speaking and doing brings receiving.

And it's healthy to be reminded of the reason *WHY* this process works. It works because God is faithful and He is good! The Bible says, "*For the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him.*"¹

Yet, without somebody preaching, there is nothing to hear! There will be no "hearing." If I don't hear, I cannot and will not believe. And if I don't believe something deep down inside, there would be no reason for me to call out or to act out in a certain way.

We, as humans, speak and act because of what we believe. What we really believe is what governs us. It is the real reason why we do what we do.

For example, the reason you go to the bank or the ATM to withdraw money is because you believe there is money in your account and that you can access it these ways. If you didn't believe that, you wouldn't randomly find yourself going to the bank one day. Likewise, nobody is going to find himself randomly calling out to a Lord about whom he has never heard. It just won't happen.

Are you beginning to gain a renewed appreciation for God's preachers? What a gift they are to us! Truth be told, we as believers in Christ are all preachers of God's simple and powerful salvation message.²

People cannot believe something they have never heard about. We also have a responsibility to tell them the good news of God's salvation plan! We aren't responsible for the reaction or response of the people, but we are responsible for the message!³

The Bible says that those who believe will *CALL*. In other words, they will *ACT* upon what they believe. And what will be the result? *"Whoever calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved."*

It's important to be reminded that the word "salvation" here is from the Greek word *SOZO*, which refers to all of man's salvation needs, including *deliverance, protection, healing, safety, and total well-being*.⁴

This passage certainly applies to God's process for receiving forgiveness and salvation from our sins, but it also extends to all of our needs and wants. And this is not just for some or only for a few. This is for as many who will learn to call upon the Lord in faith. *"For the same Lord over all is rich TO ALL who call upon Him."* God is no respecter of persons!

ALL BELIEF HAS A SOURCE

Sometimes we forget or fail to realize that it's impossible to believe something all by ourselves. It's not as if I go to sleep at night, and then the next morning when I wake up — suddenly, out of seemingly nowhere — *"I believe!"*

In truth, all faith and belief has a source! All of our beliefs, whether biblical or non-biblical, whether truth or lies, have come as a result of something we have heard at some time or another. "Hearing" is the source. That's why Jesus taught, *"Take heed what you hear."*⁵

Once again, this is why the role of a God-sent preacher is so important in our lives! Apart from God's preachers, God's people will not be able to hear God's messages, and will remain largely unable to believe what God wants them to believe!

Preaching is one of God's chosen, ordained methods that we must learn to cooperate with. It may be foolishness to some, but it is powerful and essential, nonetheless.

So, if you want to receive anything from the Lord, the process begins with preaching. Preaching is part of God's ordained method to accomplish His will in your life.

GOD PREACHED TO ABRAHAM

*Therefore He who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you, does He do it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? — **just as Abraham “believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.”** Therefore know that only those who are of faith are sons of Abraham. And the Scripture, foreseeing that **God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel to Abraham** beforehand, saying, “In you all the nations shall be blessed.”*

Galatians 3:5-8

As you read through the New Testament you will find this phrase, not once, not twice, but three times — *“Abraham believed God.”* The Scripture says, *“Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.”* And what was it that enabled Abraham to believe God? He heard preaching!

How cool is this! The Scripture says that God Himself preached the gospel to Abraham! Can you imagine hearing God’s preaching?!

Stop for just a moment here and consider this: Why would God preach to him? Of course, because this is His method! Preaching is God’s chosen, ordained method to empower us to believe what He wants us to believe,

causing faith to come so that we can receive from Him. And He even uses it Himself!

Abraham believed — Why? How? Because he had a preacher. God was his preacher!

Wouldn't you like to experience more God-activity in your life? This one thing will help for sure — more Spirit-anointed preaching! Or perhaps we need to learn how to maximize and make better use of the preaching that is currently available to us. (More is written about how to do that later in this book.)

HEAR AND BE HEALED!

However, the report went around concerning Him all the more; and great multitudes came together to hear, and to be healed by Him of their infirmities.

Luke 5:15

Through the gospel writings, we read about the life and ministry of Jesus and all the great healings and miracles He performed. Without reading carefully, it can be easy to miss this important fact: ***Not only was Jesus a healer and miracle-worker, but He was also a Spirit-anointed preacher and teacher!***

*Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, **teaching** in their synagogues, **preaching** the gospel*

*of the kingdom, **and healing** every sickness and every disease among the people.*

Matthew 9:35

Without the understanding of this lesson, one might inaccurately conclude that Jesus went around from place to place, randomly releasing some healing power here and some healing power there, performing miracles here and performing miracles there.

But upon closer look, we discover that many of those who were healed under Jesus' ministry also "heard" His preaching and teaching. We often read that they came "*to hear AND be healed.*" The hearing was part of the healing!

Unfortunately, many are trying to receive healing today but haven't taken time to first sit down and hear God's anointed message in regard to His will and desire to heal. Or even worse, some may even be hearing all the reasons why God doesn't heal today, or how God will allow sickness in your life to teach and perfect you.

Can you imagine how much confusion and conflict that creates within your own heart?! And what's all too often the result? Lots of prayers, even begging and pleading — but no healing! This sort of scenario is never God's will!

I ask you again, does God give you the Holy Spirit and work miracles among you because you obey the law? Of course not! It is because you believe the message you heard about Christ.

Galatians 3:5 (NLT)

This verse makes it so clear! Does the Lord work miracles in our lives and give us His precious Holy Spirit because we do everything perfectly? Of course not! Thank God, we are not on a “merit system” when it comes to our inheritance in Christ. Thank God, these things have been *freely given* and provided through Christ’s redemptive work on the cross!

If we can’t earn the Holy Spirit and God’s miracles, on what grounds does He do these things for us? He does it because “we believe the message that we heard.”

Faith comes by hearing! But how can you hear without a preacher? There must be preaching!



CHAPTER FIVE

PREACHING PLANTS SEEDS

And He said, “The kingdom of God is as if a man should scatter seed on the ground, and should sleep by night and rise by day, and the seed should sprout and grow, he himself does not know how.”

Mark 4:26,27

When preaching takes place and the message is being received, seeds are being planted! What a powerful concept! The entire kingdom of God functions this way. That’s why Jesus said, *“Take heed what you hear.”*¹

Whatever you hear is going to get planted in you. And unfortunately, that works for the good stuff as well as the bad. It works for the truth that we hear, and it also works for any lies that we embrace.

The more we understand this powerful truth, the more ***selective*** we will be about what we allow ourselves to listen to. Likewise, the more understanding we have, the more we will begin to look for and listen to preaching — ***on purpose!***

IT'S UP TO YOU!

The Bible teaches us that we are *God's garden and God's field*.² Everyone knows what you do with a garden. You plant seeds! Not only that, but if it's *YOUR* garden, then you have the right *to choose* what kind of seeds you want to plant.

What you choose to sow depends upon what exactly you want to grow!

- o If I want to grow tomatoes, I must plant tomato seeds.
- o If I want to grow watermelon, I must plant watermelon seeds.
- o If I want to grow cucumbers, I must sow cucumber seeds.

It's my garden, so it's really up to me! There is no point in wondering why I don't have any carrots growing in my garden if I didn't plant any carrot seeds. Without the planting of the seed, there can be no harvest. It's just that simple!

The same is true in our spiritual lives. For example, if we want to receive God's will and full provision financially, then we should hear preaching about God's will and provision for us financially. If we want to

receive God's will regarding His protection and keeping power, then we should hear preaching specifically about His protection. If we want to grow and develop in the character of Christ, then we must hear preaching about Christ's character. The list goes on and on!

NO SEED...NO HARVEST

In the time of need or crises, many are trying to call out to the Lord for healing, provision, guidance, or protection. But there's one small problem. ***No significant seed has been sown!*** They are looking for a harvest without taking the time to sow any seed. And in this case, what allows the seed to be sown? Preaching!

Faith comes by *HEARING*, and hearing by the Word of God. What have you been hearing lately? Or a better question may be: What have you NOT been hearing lately? It could be that what you are *not hearing* is the reason why *you don't have* the fruit and manifestation of God's will that you desire and are looking for.

The Apostle Paul wrote to the believers at Corinth saying, "*I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase.*"³ What kind of planting was he referring to? He was referring to the planting and sowing of the Word of God, which he did *through preaching*.

What kind of watering was he referring to? He was referring to the watering of God's Word that happens when we hear the same truths repeated and reiterated.

Everyone knows it's not enough to just plant a seed. The seeds we have planted must then be watered to reach healthy growth and harvest. That's why we are always thankful to hear the same Bible truths over and over again, knowing that in some cases seeds are being planted, and in other cases seeds are being watered!

*Therefore, whether it was I or they, **so we preach** and **so you believed**.*

1 Corinthians 15:11

Here we get a revelation of WHY Paul was preaching — so that they could believe! This is God's chosen method.

I often wonder — ***are we taking full advantage of the preachers that God has released into the earth for our benefit?***

Sometimes we only listen to one preacher, who only emphasizes one particular truth. Perhaps salvation is emphasized. Without question, that's a very important truth and message! But there are also other truths we must hear. There are other seeds that must also be planted in our garden.

It's possible to have faith for the salvation of souls but not have any personal faith for healing, divine protection, family life, or God's provision. If we are wise, we will hear God's words for each and every area that we want to be strong in our receiving from God.

**Preaching is powerful because it exposes you!
It exposes you to God's thoughts and to
what's in His mind concerning you.**



CHAPTER SIX

HOW TO COOPERATE WITH PREACHING

As I've written previously, this thing called "preaching" is something that we must awaken to and become more aware of.

Not only do we want to put ourselves in a position to hear *more preaching*, but we also want to learn *how to hear better*. In other words, we want to learn how to better cooperate with the preachers and the preaching that is already in our midst.

Here are a few practical tips that I believe will make a significant difference in your life!

- 1. Give God thanks for His ordained preachers in your life, recognizing their role.**

*And we urge you, brethren, to **recognize those who labor among you**, and are over you in the Lord and admonish you, and to esteem them very highly in love for their work's sake. Be at peace among yourselves.*

1 Thessalonians 5:12,13

Something powerful happens when we begin to recognize our preachers “by name” and thank God for them, understanding their role in our lives. This simple step of recognition and honor will open your heart to receive God’s message through them at an even higher, more concentrated level.

We must remember that these are *God’s messengers*, carrying *God’s message*. Therefore, it’s only appropriate that we would return thanks to God, since He is the One who sent them for our benefit.

- o Who are the preachers that you recognize God has sent into your life?
- o Are you able to name them specifically?
- o Have you taken time to thank God for them, recognizing the important role they have in your life?

It can be all too easy to criticize or become offended with the preacher, because he somehow failed to meet your personal expectations of him. Maybe he failed to greet you at church, shake your hand, or respond to your personal invitation to join you for lunch.

We should always remember that the preacher’s highest role in our lives is not to be our friend, or to go to lunch with us. (That may happen in rare instances.)

His highest role is TO PREACH — so that we can believe!
This is why God has ordained preachers.

In some cases, you may never know the preacher personally or engage with him on a very private level. But none of that is required to make the most of why he was sent to you.

**The preacher was sent to deliver a message
so that you can believe!**

And if you can believe, you can respond to God, for yourself, from your heart — that's called faith! And let's not forget — God rewards faith!

There is only One Mediator between God and man, and it's not the preacher! It is The Man — Christ Jesus!¹ When the preacher is able to fully do his job and his message is received, it will always enhance and improve your personal relationship with the Lord.

God, and God alone, desires to be *your source* and provide all that you need and desire in every area of life. The preacher plays a very significant role in that becoming a reality for you!

2. Always pray for the preacher before entering a church service or bible seminar.

and for me, that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel,

Ephesians 6:19

Praying for the preacher is always for your benefit! So, for me personally, it has become a habit to always pray for the preacher and the message BEFORE attending church or a bible seminar.

When I go to church, I recognize that God has something to say to me through that preacher. I am not interested in random thoughts or ideas that come from a man's mind. I can turn on the television and find that most anywhere. I want to hear God's inspired words! These are the kind of words that will enable faith to come alive inside of me.

Praying for the preacher and the message doesn't necessarily require long sessions of deep prayer and intercession. It can be as simple as saying,

"Lord, I know You have something to say to me today. I ask You to give Your words and Your message to my preacher. Help him to speak boldly and accurately today. Lord, I am not coming to hear from a man today. I am coming to hear from You!"

In the book of Ephesians, the Apostle Paul asked the church for prayer, *“that utterance (words) may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel.”*

I find it interesting that the great Apostle Paul, who had so much divine revelation and insight, was dependent upon the prayers of the people to deliver the message. The message was inside the man, but the desire, faith, and prayers of the people were necessary to bring the message out! The same is true today.

That’s why it is so important for us to pray for our ministers and preachers before they preach God’s words. If we will be diligent to pray for our preachers, God will be faithful not only to give the preacher the right message, but then also to put His Spirit and anointing upon him to deliver that message. And that is exactly what we are looking for — words of Spirit and life!²

Let’s not forget why this is so important. Spirit-anointed preaching causes faith to come! Hearing the right messages will supernaturally cause the right seeds to be planted within us, thereby producing the kind of harvest we want!

WORDS OF SPIRIT AND POWER

The Apostle Paul had this to say to the believers who lived in Corinth, *“And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and power.”*³ So when our preacher stands up to speak to us, we don’t want him to speak words of human wisdom, but words that demonstrate God’s Spirit and power!

When Jesus was physically alive on the earth, people would often marvel *“because He spoke as One having authority.”*⁴ He was speaking Spirit-anointed words that were given to Him by the Father God. Should His ministers and representatives be any less anointed and empowered today?

Even today’s preachers are exhorted to speak as of the oracles of God, and with the ability which God Himself supplies!⁵ That’s amazing! And our prayers for the preacher play a significant role in that becoming a reality.

3. Never be afraid to embrace preaching beyond your current physical reality, provided it agrees with Scripture.

while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things

which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal.

2 Corinthians 4:18

This is such an important and powerful revelation! We must always remember that the preacher's job is not to just reiterate or rehash "current events" and the things that already exist around us. These are things that we already know and that are already quite obvious. You can turn on the nightly news to get a full report of these things!

The preacher's job is to give us something (and Someone!) greater to believe — beyond what we see — beyond our current reality! The preacher's job is to tell us *the report of the Lord!*⁶

If a preacher is Spirit guided and anointed, more often than not, he will be speaking of *things that are NOT YET SEEN* in our lives. His job is to preach to us and to speak to us about things not yet seen or realized so that these unseen things can also become our own personal reality! That's part of his job, and what God has sent him to do.

The Bible says that God *manifests His Word through preaching.*⁷ What does that mean? That means that His words become our reality through preaching! Remember, preaching is God's ordained method!

Sometimes the truths proclaimed to you from God's word will seem so far beyond your present state or reality. That's not the time to fear or to turn off the message. That's the time to reach out and wholeheartedly receive the message being delivered to you!

So long as what is being preached agrees with the Scriptures and the witness of the Holy Spirit within our hearts, we should train ourselves to be *quick to believe*, even though what we are hearing seems so far away from our current condition or reality.

Think about this:

- o God will speak to you about the reality of salvation and eternity in heaven while you are still totally lost in your sins.
- o God will speak to you about divine health and healing even while you are sick, weak, and the doctors have given you up to die.
- o God will speak to you about His will to provide for you and to prosper you abundantly even while you may be unemployed and can't seem to make your electricity payment.
- o God will speak to you about His plan and purpose for your life even when you have taken every

personality test, met with guidance counselors, and still have no clue what to do with your life.

- o God will speak to you about a dream marriage and having your own family even when you haven't had an interesting date for more than three years.

What is real faith? The Bible says, "*Faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.*"⁸ How could we ever be certain and sure about something that is still unseen? Through preaching!

The image of God's Word and will comes alive inside of us as we hear the message! Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God! This is God's supernatural process!

In order to experience God's Word on the outside, we must first believe it on the inside. An undeniable part of this process is preaching!

4. Seek out preaching in any given area that you want to receive from God.

Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap.

Galatians 6:7

THE P©WER OF PREACHING

- o Do you want to experience God's miracle healing power in your life? Seek out preaching about God's will to heal you.
- o Do you want to discover your purpose and why you were created? Seek out messages about your purpose and God's plan for your life.
- o Do you want to experience more of God's power? Seek out messages about the Holy Spirit and His ministry in your life.
- o Do you want to walk in greater levels of Christian character? Seek out messages about integrity and the character of Christ.
- o Do you want to travel in the future and do missionary work? Seek out messages from past missionaries and be inspired by how God worked in their lives.
- o Do you want to experience God's abundant financial plan, enabling you to do more to help others and to advance God's purposes? Seek out messages about God's will to prosper you, wisdom, and stewardship.
- o Do you want to experience God's promotion and exaltation in your life? Seek out messages about humility and honor.

- o Do you want to live out a full life and hear “*Well done, good and faithful servant*”? Seek out messages about God’s will and eternal rewards.

I suppose we should stop and ask this very important question: ***What do we really want?*** With this kind of revelation, we can’t really just leave everything up to the Lord, when in fact, He has left so much up to us and within our own power.

Let’s not forget that the messages we hear plant seeds in our hearts, and that every seed produces after its own kind.⁹ You cannot get an apple tree from a watermelon seed! Likewise, you will not see a harvest of divine healing in your life by hearing about prayer and church growth every week. If we are wise, we will plant seeds in each and every area that we desire to see a harvest of God’s will.

If we only hear about what we currently have, it will just perpetuate and produce more of the same! So what’s the proactive solution?

- o ***More hearing*** (make more time for hearing God’s messages)
- o ***Selective hearing*** (choosing those specific messages that we desire to see manifest)
- o ***Better hearing*** (making better use of our church services and opportunities)

It's important for us to take responsibility for our lives, not only in a natural sense, but also spiritually. We can do this by proactively listening to messages and planting seeds in the areas where we desire to see God's harvest in our lives.

5. Incorporate preaching and hearing God's Word as a regular part of your lifestyle.

"Now the just shall live by faith..."

Hebrews 10:38

This is very easy to do in today's high-tech media world. Podcasts and audio and video recordings are available and accessible of most anything you want to hear about. That can be good, but also not so good! With all of that information available, all the more you will want to ask God for discernment and protection in regard to what you spend your time listening to.

You don't just want to hear anything from anyone. You want to hear *HIS WORDS* from those whom He has sent and anointed to speak on various subjects. It's necessary to ask God to lead you to and reveal to you that which He wants you to hear on any given subject. This is also very, very important! Doing more of something is not always good, particularly if it's the wrong something!

As you begin to locate who and what the Lord wants you to listen to, make it a regular habit and part of your lifestyle. You will be amazed at how quickly this will begin to shape and impact your life! You can listen while you are getting ready for work in the morning, while cleaning the house, exercising, or even when you are stuck in traffic!

Repetition is a powerful thing! It's good to listen to messages long enough and often enough until you begin to notice that *it's coming out of your mouth* without even thinking twice.

- o You will find yourself wanting to tell others about it.
- o You will find yourself looking through life's lens through the filter of what you have been hearing.

This is how you know it's beginning to go to work for you!

The Bible says, "*out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks.*"¹⁰ When God's words get firmly planted in our hearts, they will eventually start coming out of our mouths. They will begin to affect our actions and all that we say and do!

This is faith! This is what pleases God! This is the victory that overcomes the world! And all of this begins with this wonderful thing called "*PREACHING.*"

THIS WILL WORK FOR YOU!

Friend, I want to encourage you today. No matter what state or status you may find yourself in, God loves you and has already made a way of escape for you! All that you need is faith in God!

Your faith in God is the very thing that will enable you to overcome all that life could ever throw at you! But here is a big key: *FAITH COMES BY HEARING GOD'S WORD.*

Let's not make the mistake of trying to find faith anywhere else, except from where God said we will find it.

- o Ask God to send you a preacher to help you!
- o Ask God to send you the messages you need to hear so that faith can quickly and easily come alive on the inside of you!

And then, be on the lookout! Keep your eyes and ears open! He will do it for you!

God is not hard, harsh, or demanding. In fact, His yoke is easy and His burden is light!¹¹ He has given us His wonderful methods, but we must learn to put these methods to work in our lives.



FOR REVIEW AND REFLECTION

- When Spirit-anointed preaching and teaching are happening, we are engaged in a supernatural, God-ordained process.
- Receiving from God is a process. There is a kingdom process of receiving from the Lord.
- God is not willing that any should perish, but that all should be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth.
- Preaching is one of God's CHOSEN METHODS.
- Once God ordains a method, that's His method! You can't change it, but you can learn how to cooperate with it.
- God, in His sovereignty, has bound Himself to His Word. He will always move within the confines of what He has said.

THE PⓄWER OF PREACHING

- God can do anything, but His power will be limited or released in our lives on the basis of what we believe.
- Once you realize God can do anything, it's also important to ask yourself, "*What do I believe?*"
- Trying to believe God for something outside of what His Word reveals is presumption.
- What we believe and ask God for must be according to what He has said.
- Our own unbelief will limit and "shut down" the power of God in our lives.
- God moves where He finds faith!
- Teaching and preaching is a Bible-cure for unbelief.
- If you will stop for a moment and listen to what you are saying, you will discover what you really believe.
- What you really believe is what comes out of your mouth in everyday life when the pressure is on.
- If we doubt when we ask God for something, we will not receive.

- It is impossible to please God without faith.
- Faith is the very thing that allows God to get involved in human affairs.
- God is always willing and ready to get involved whenever and wherever He is called upon.
- If you are a born-again child of God, you are a believer! You are not a doubter!
- Faith and believing is a result of preaching.
- Faith is the currency of the kingdom of God.
- Through the new birth in Christ, we are now part of God's holy nation — the kingdom of God.
- Through preaching, you can get your hands on the currency of God's kingdom — faith.
- The Lord's receiving process will work for anyone who desires to put it to work!
- God's preachers are His gifts to us.
- People cannot believe something they have never heard about.

- All faith and belief has a source — hearing!
- Apart from God’s preachers, His people will not be able to hear His messages and will remain largely unable to believe what God wants them to believe.
- Preaching is God’s chosen, ordained method to empower us to believe what He wants us to believe, causing faith to come, so that we can receive from Him.
- Many of those who were healed under Jesus’ earthly ministry *also heard* His preaching and teaching.
- Many are trying to receive healing today but haven’t taken time to first sit down and hear God’s anointed message regarding His will and desire to heal.
- We are not on a “merit system” when it comes to our inheritance in Christ. Our inheritance has been freely given and provided through Christ’s redemptive work on the cross.
- When preaching takes place and the message is being received, seeds are being planted.

- Whatever you hear is going to get planted in you, whether it be good or bad.
- We should be selective about what we allow ourselves to listen to.
- You have the right to choose exactly what seeds you want to sow into the garden of your heart. It depends upon what you want to grow!
- Without the planting of the seed, there can be no harvest — period!
- What you ARE NOT hearing could be the very reason why you DON'T HAVE the manifestation of God's will that you desire.
- When we take time to hear God's truths reiterated, *seeds are being WATERED*. Both planting and watering are necessary for a harvest!
- If we are wise, we will hear God's words for each and every area that we want to be strong in our receiving from God.
- Not only do we want to hear *more preaching*, but we also want to learn *how to hear better*.

THE P[®]OWER OF PREACHING

- Recognizing and honoring God's preachers in your life will open your heart to receive God's message through them at an even higher level!
- The preacher's highest role in your life is not to be your personal friend. His highest role is TO PREACH — so that you can believe!
- There is only One Mediator between God and man, and it is The Man — Christ Jesus.
- God, and God alone, desires to be your source and provide all that you need and desire in every area of life.
- Praying for the preacher is always for your benefit.
- The message may be inside the preacher, but the desire, faith, and prayers of the people are necessary to bring that message out!
- Hearing Spirit-anointed preaching will cause the right seeds to be planted within us, thereby producing the kind of harvest we want.
- We will not benefit from hearing words of human wisdom, but words that demonstrate God's Spirit and power.

- The preacher's job is not to reiterate or rehash current events, but to give us something greater to believe — beyond our current reality.
- God manifests (makes visible) His Word through preaching.
- The truths proclaimed from God's Word will sometimes seem far beyond your present state or reality.
- We should train ourselves to be *quick to believe*, even though what we are hearing may seem far from our current reality.
- Through preaching, we can become *certain and sure* about things that are still unseen in our lives. This is the aim of preaching!
- In order to experience God's Word *on the outside*, we must first believe it *on the inside*.
- We should stop and ask, "*What do we really want?*" We can't leave up to the Lord what He has already left within our own power.
- If we are wise, we will plant seeds in each and every area that we desire to see a harvest of God's will.

THE P[®]OWER OF PREACHING

- If we only hear about what we currently have, it will only perpetuate and produce more of the same!
- One way we can begin to take responsibility for our lives is to proactively listen to messages in the areas where we desire to see God's harvest in our lives.
- Ask God to lead you and reveal to you that which He wants you to hear on any given subject.
- Listening to God's messages as a regular part of your lifestyle will quickly begin to shape and impact your life!
- Listen to messages long enough and often enough, until you notice that it's coming out of your mouth without even thinking about it.

APPENDIX A

A PRAYER OF SALVATION

The FIRST step for you to have a greater understanding of the power of preaching and to fully cooperate with this God-ordained process is to receive Jesus as your personal Lord and Savior.

Jesus is the Son of God, who died on the cross and shed His blood to pay the price for the sins of the whole world. The Bible tells us that *“whoever calls on the name of the Lord [Jesus] shall be saved.”* (Rom. 10:13)

The Scripture also tells us *“that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.”* (Rom. 10:9)

If you have never taken this FIRST STEP, then pray this simple prayer in sincerity from your heart:

*“Dear God,

the cross to pay the penalty for my sins. I believe
that Jesus has been raised from the dead and that
He is alive! Right now I call on the name of Jesus.
Jesus, come into my heart. I receive You as my
personal Lord and Savior. Forgive me of my sins
and cleanse me by the power of Your blood. Thank
You for saving me and giving me eternal life! Help
me now to follow Your plan for my life. Amen.”*

Congratulations! You are now a child of God!

APPENDIX B

A PRAYER TO RECEIVE THE HOLY SPIRIT

“But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem...”

Acts 1:8

The moment you receive Jesus as your personal Lord and Savior, the Holy Spirit comes to dwell **within you**. You then have become the temple or dwelling place of God’s Spirit. But there is more of the Holy Spirit that God wants you to experience!

The promise of the Spirit was given to empower us to walk in the plan that God has prepared for us. The Holy Spirit is God’s gift to us, His children, so that we can enter into all the fullness of God! All we must do is **receive this gift**. This experience is called the baptism of the Holy Spirit, or the Holy Spirit coming **upon us**.

If you want to experience the fullness of life that God intended for you to have with the benefit of praying in tongues, pray this simple prayer from your heart:

“Heavenly Father, I come to You in the name of Jesus. Your Word says that You will give the Holy

Spirit to those who ask You. I ask You now to fill me with Your Holy Spirit. I want to experience Your fullness in my life!"

"I release my faith and expect to speak with other tongues as the Holy Spirit will give me the utterance. I thank You, Father, for the gift of the Holy Spirit and the ability to speak with other tongues. In Jesus' name. Amen!"

Begin to thank Him now for filling you with His Holy Spirit. Yield yourself to Him. Speak the words — not in your own language — but in a language that the Holy Spirit gives you (speaking in tongues). It is you who will do the speaking, not the Holy Spirit.

Praise the Lord daily for this wonderful gift of being able to communicate with Him spirit to Spirit!
